## The Fold Model to achieve unparalleled results

- Prior offenders in need of a Home Plan for release apply to the Fold, which is a six month program operated in two phases. Services provided include: **sharing the Gospel faithfully, providing food, shelter, clothing, evening programming four nights per week, help with ID cards, aid in finding employment, basic financial knowledge courses, team-building adventures, literacy assistance, & help obtaining a GED diploma.** We also operate a graduate apartment community in Alabaster for anyone graduating from local rehab/re-entry programs.
- Our model stands unique in the market place for 2 reasons:1st- our success rate for graduates of the Fold is truly exceptional. As a percent, we currently estimate rights at 65 to 70% of our full program graduates remain free out of prison. Compare this to the average prior offender who returns to prison in 76% of the cases. Only 23% remain free. 2nd over the past 29 years of service, we have ministered to right at 1,680 men & women. No one in this state has done more. Further, each dollar donated to the Fold saves the agony of untold new crimes committed & saves an estimated \$19,000 of your tax dollars spent on incarceration each year as people revert to their old habits, commit new crimes & return to prison.
